


# **Setting Up Your Parent Account**

To create a parent account at <a href="www.senecalearning.com">www.senecalearning.com</a> you will need to use a personal email and then link it to your child's Seneca account. Please use the email that you have registered with the school.



You can then sign up by using your Google or Microsoft account. You can also use any other personal email of your choice.

When you create your account, select "I'm a parent".








# **Connecting to Your Child's Account**

Parents can link their Seneca account to their child's account to monitor progress and study activity. Once you have created a Seneca parent account, follow these steps to connect to your child:

- 1. Click "Connect Your Child's Account" This option allows you to generate a unique link.
- 2. Share the Link Send the link to your child via email or messaging apps like WhatsApp.
- 3. Child Opens the Link Your child must open the link while logged into their Seneca account on their usual device.
- 4. Confirmation Email Once the link is opened, you'll receive an email confirming the accounts are connected.




After linking, parents can view their child's study time, assignments, and progress reports. If needed, they can disconnect the account through their settings.




For extra guidance, the screenshots below demonstrate the parent and child connection process.

Alternatively, your child can also add your parent account through their account directly.



# **Using Seneca Parent Platform**


In the Seneca Parent App, the navigation bar includes:

- Home Overview of study activity, completed assignments, and progress.
- Assignments List of completed and overdue tasks with performance details.
- Reports Breakdown of study time, scores, and progress trends over time.




#### Home Page

The Parent Platform Home Page on Seneca Learning provides an overview of your child's study activity, helping you track their progress and engagement. When you log in, you'll see a dashboard displaying study data, including completed assignments, study time, and quiz scores. The homepage also features a live feed, showing real-time updates on study sessions, XP earned, and performance in exam-style questions.





If you have multiple children linked to your account, you can switch between them by selecting their name .






#### Checking Work (Assignments)

The "Assignments" tab in the parent platform allows parents to check tasks that have been set for students and track progress. Teachers can create standard assignments, select specific topics and set due dates. They can also include exam-style questions to assess understanding.

Assignments are categorised as:


- <u>To Do</u>: Pending work with deadlines.
- <u>Done</u>: Completed assignments (view scores).
- Missed: Overdue tasks.

The below screenshot shows an example of the "<u>To do</u>" page of this section. This shows the current tasks your child has been assigned and when they are due.








By selecting the set assignment heading, you can get more information on the assignments that have been set.






By clicking on the "<u>Preview</u>" option, you can have a look at the exact task your child has been asked to complete.




However, your child must be logged in to complete the assignment.





#### Study Reports

The Reports section in the Seneca Parent Platform provides a detailed breakdown of your child's study progress. It includes weekly study reports, showing total study time broken down by day and subject, along with comparisons to previous weeks. Parents can also view assignment scores and due dates, helping them track completed and overdue tasks. The section also offers average scores for each topic, allowing parents to see strengths and areas for improvement.






### Parent Platform Settings

The Settings section in the Seneca Parent Platform allows parents to manage their account preferences and adjust various features. You can do the following:

- Update Account Details Change your email, password, or linked student accounts.
- Notification Preferences Customize email alerts and study updates.
- Manage Linked Accounts Add or remove connections to your child's Seneca account.
- Privacy & Security Adjust settings to ensure a secure experience.



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# **How to Support Your Child**

- ✓ Encourage consistency. Regular short sessions (15–20 minutes) are more effective than cramming.
- ✔ Review assignments and use the "To Do" list to remind your child of deadlines.
- ✓ Use weekly reports to praise improvements and progress.
- ✓ If assignments are unclear or progress stalls, reach out to the school or teacher.
- ✓ If your child is having login issues. Check they are using their school email or SSO (Google/Microsoft).
- ✓ No assignments? Confirm with the school that teachers have set tasks or that your child is connected to the class.
