7. Read all correspondence from the school and respond quickly when necessary
8. Encourage a positive attitude to school

2. Provide high quality teaching and a variety of enrichment activities
3. Provide a balanced curriculum, set and mark homework and enable students to enjoy learning.

5. Contact parents if there is a concern about attendance, punctuality, work or behaviour.
6. Keep parents informed of their son's/daughter's academic progress.
7. Create opportunities for students to build good relationships and develop a sense of responsibility and pride in the school.
8. Have a clearly stated, published behaviour policy
